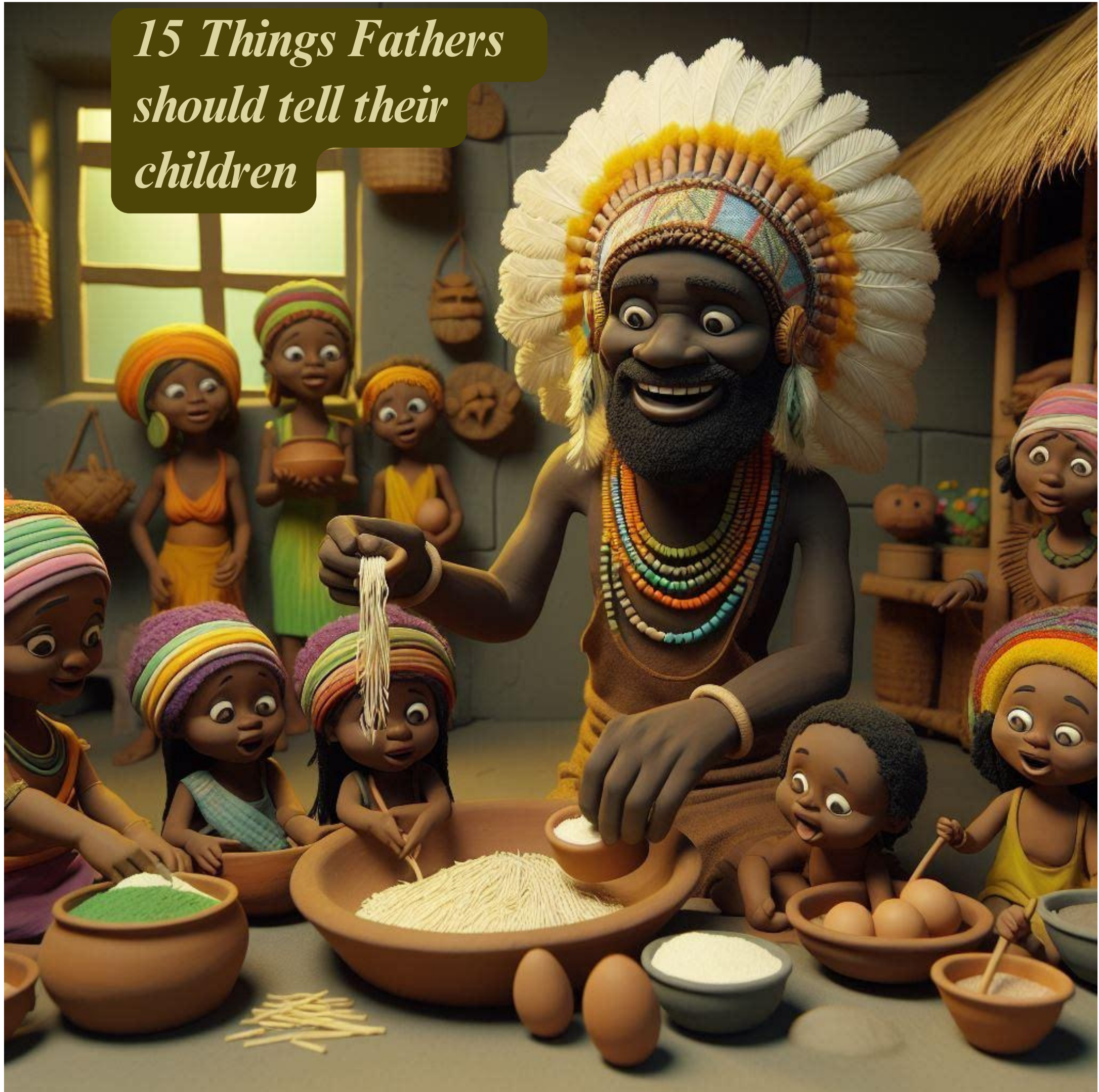


*15 Things Fathers

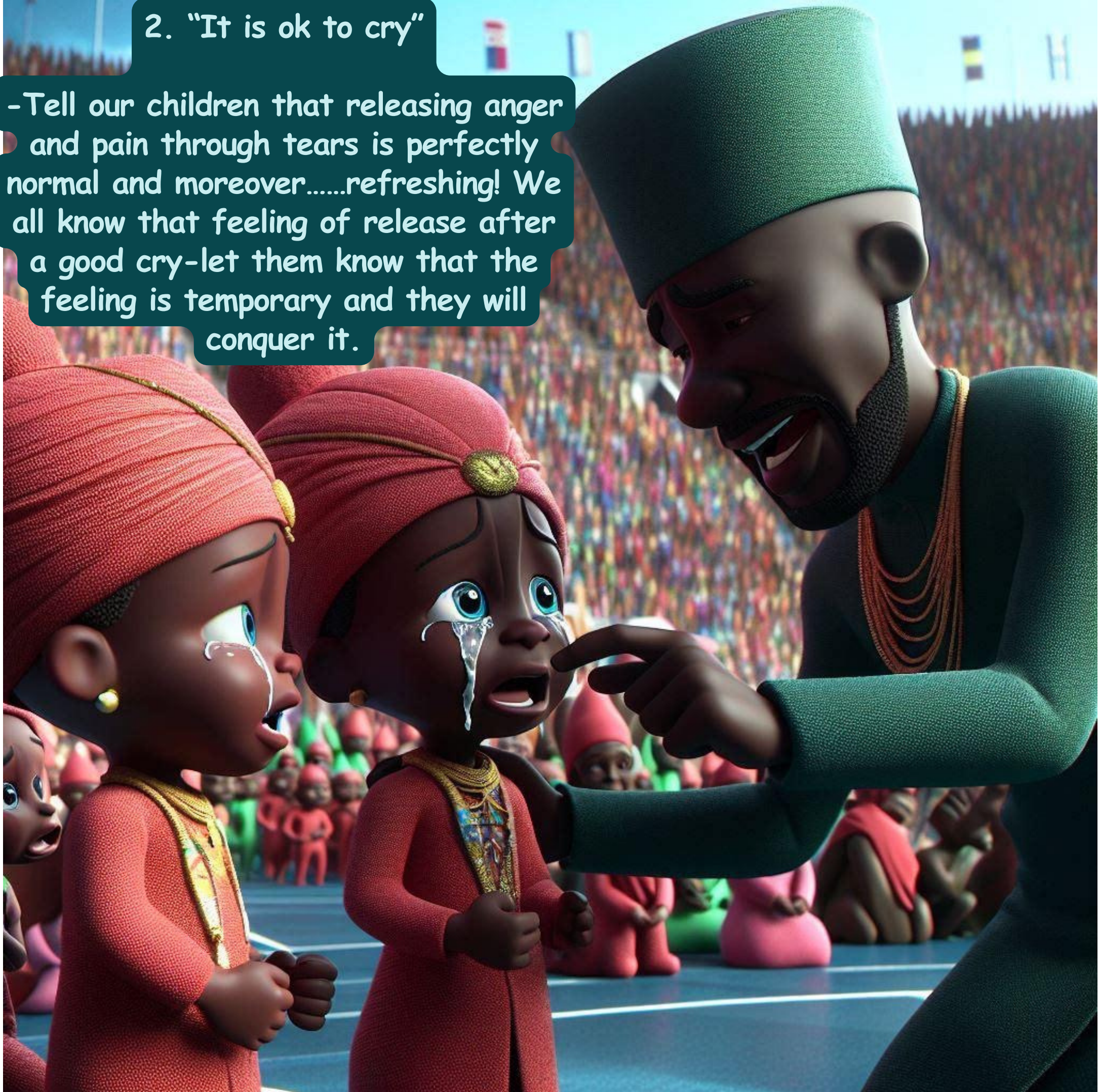
"I love you"

2. "It is ok to cry"

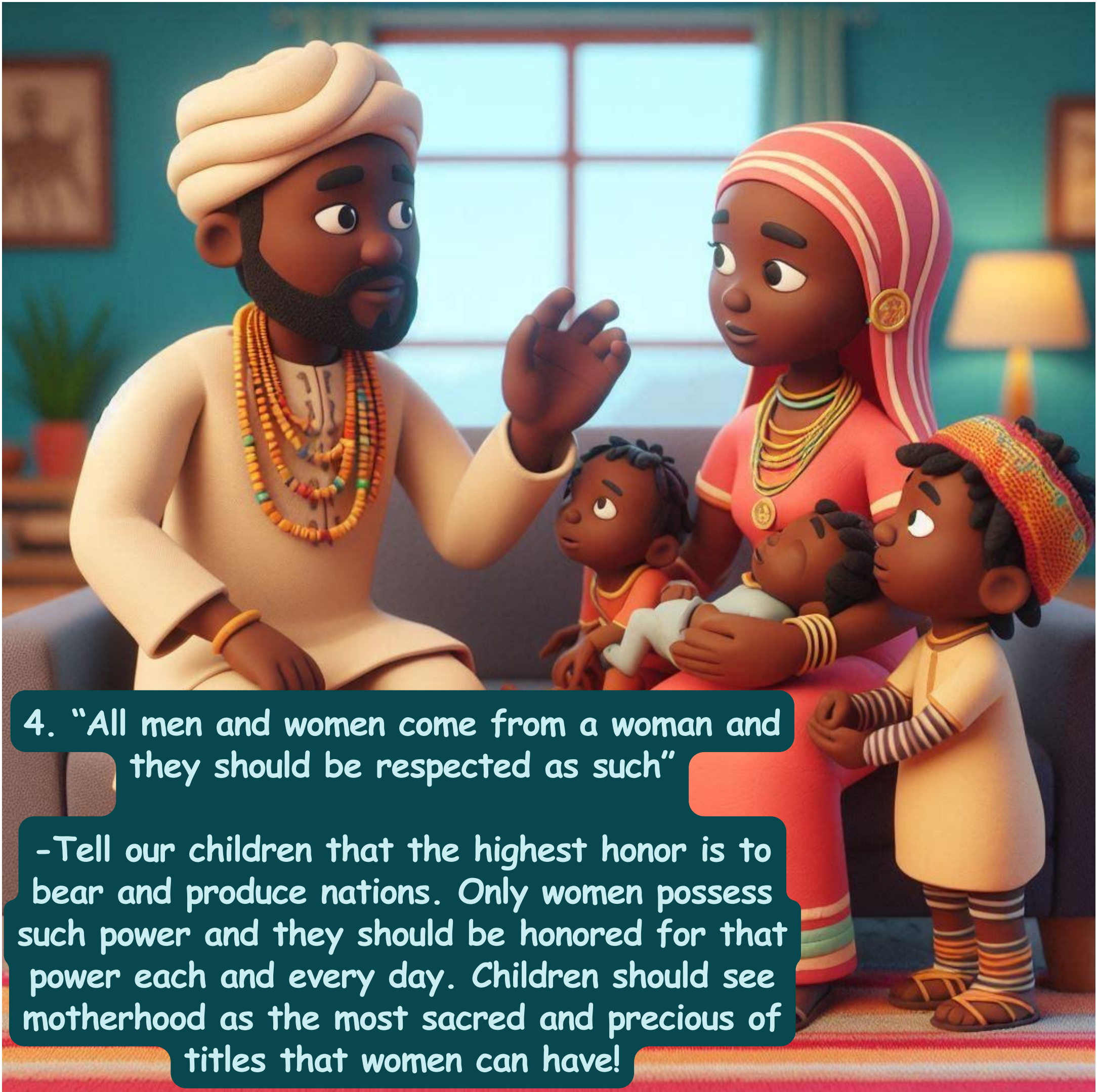


3. "Be proactive and not reactive"

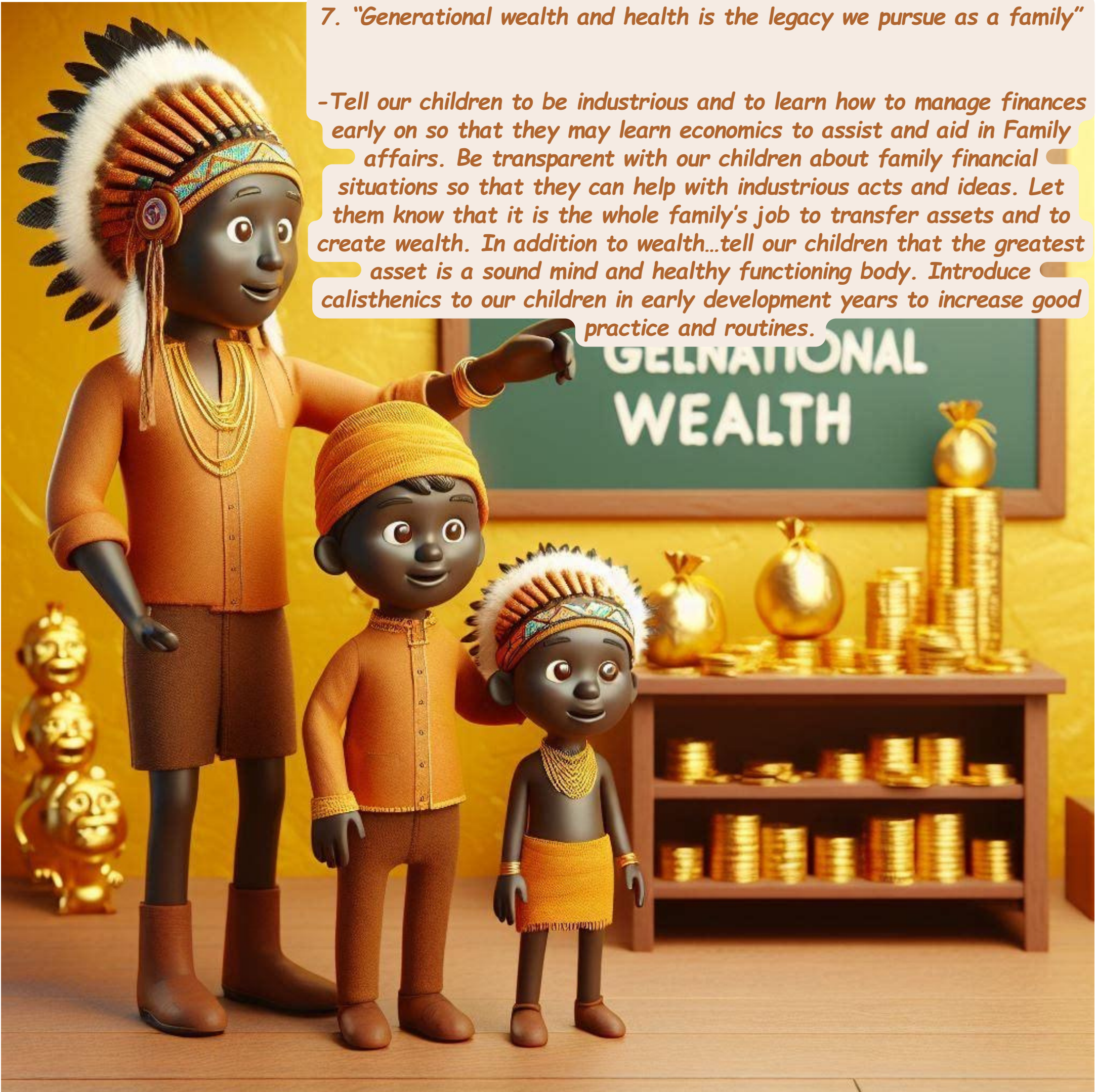
6. "The luxury of life is being a child"

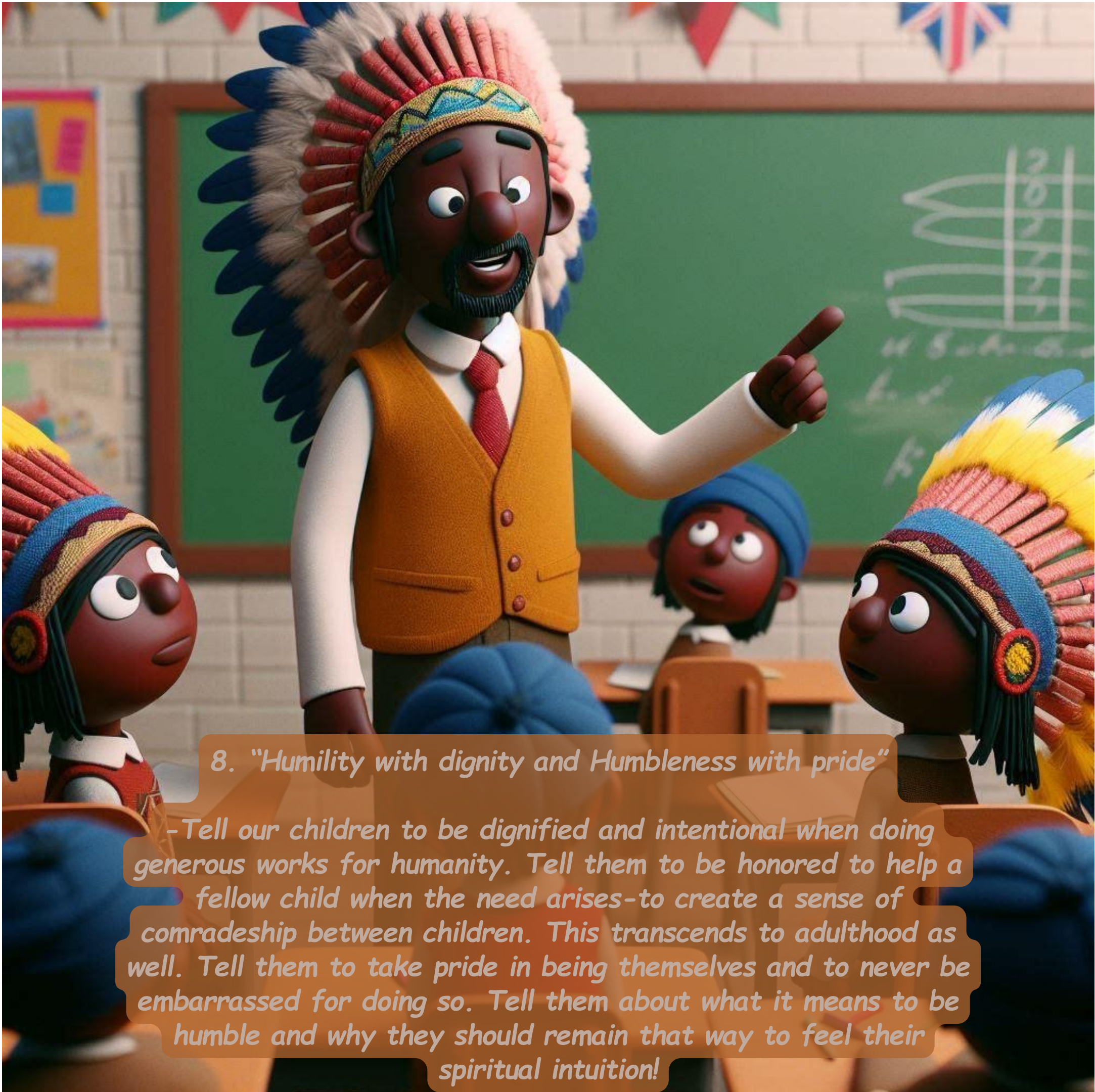

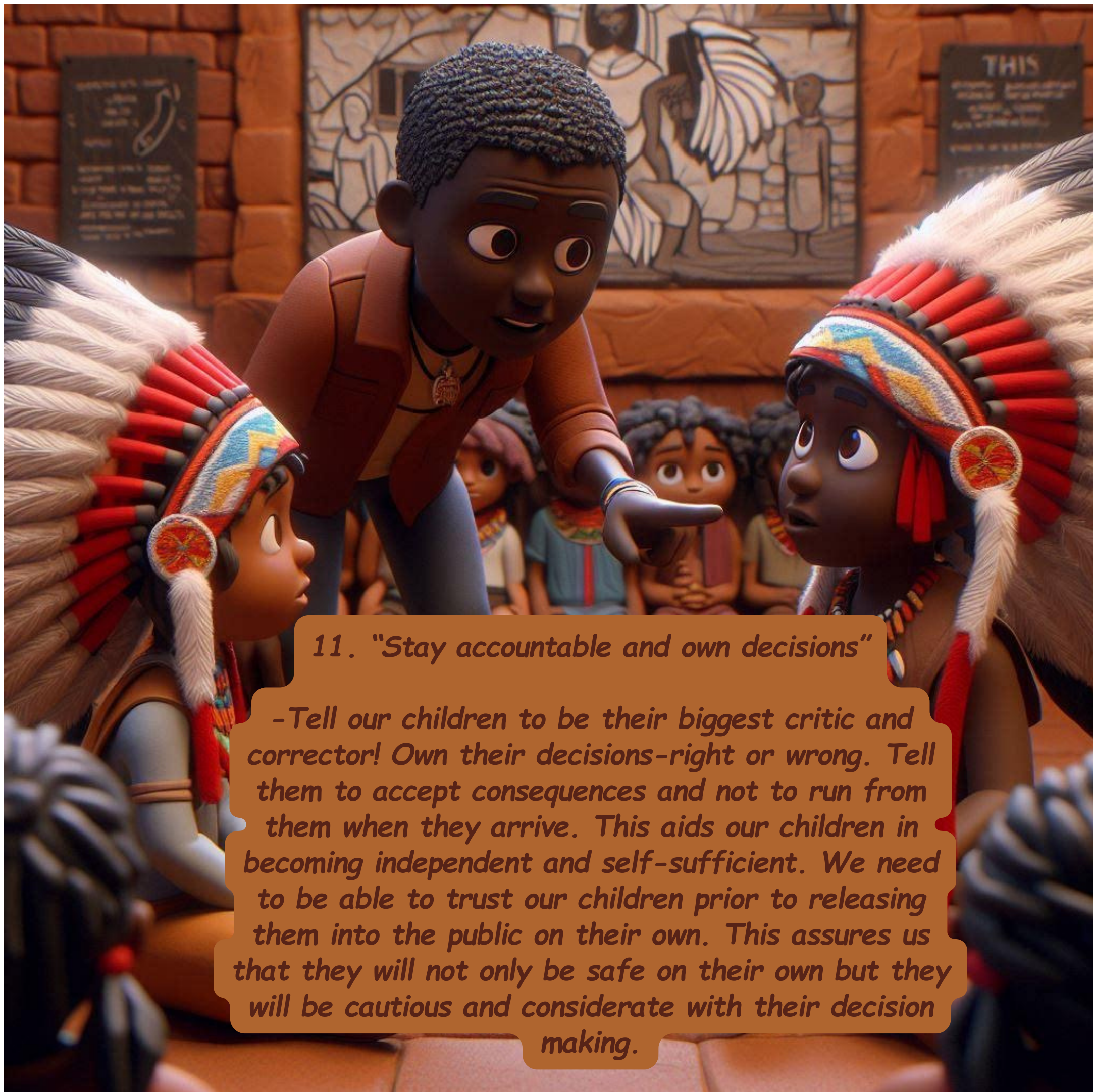
9. "You gain wisdom through good listening and observation"

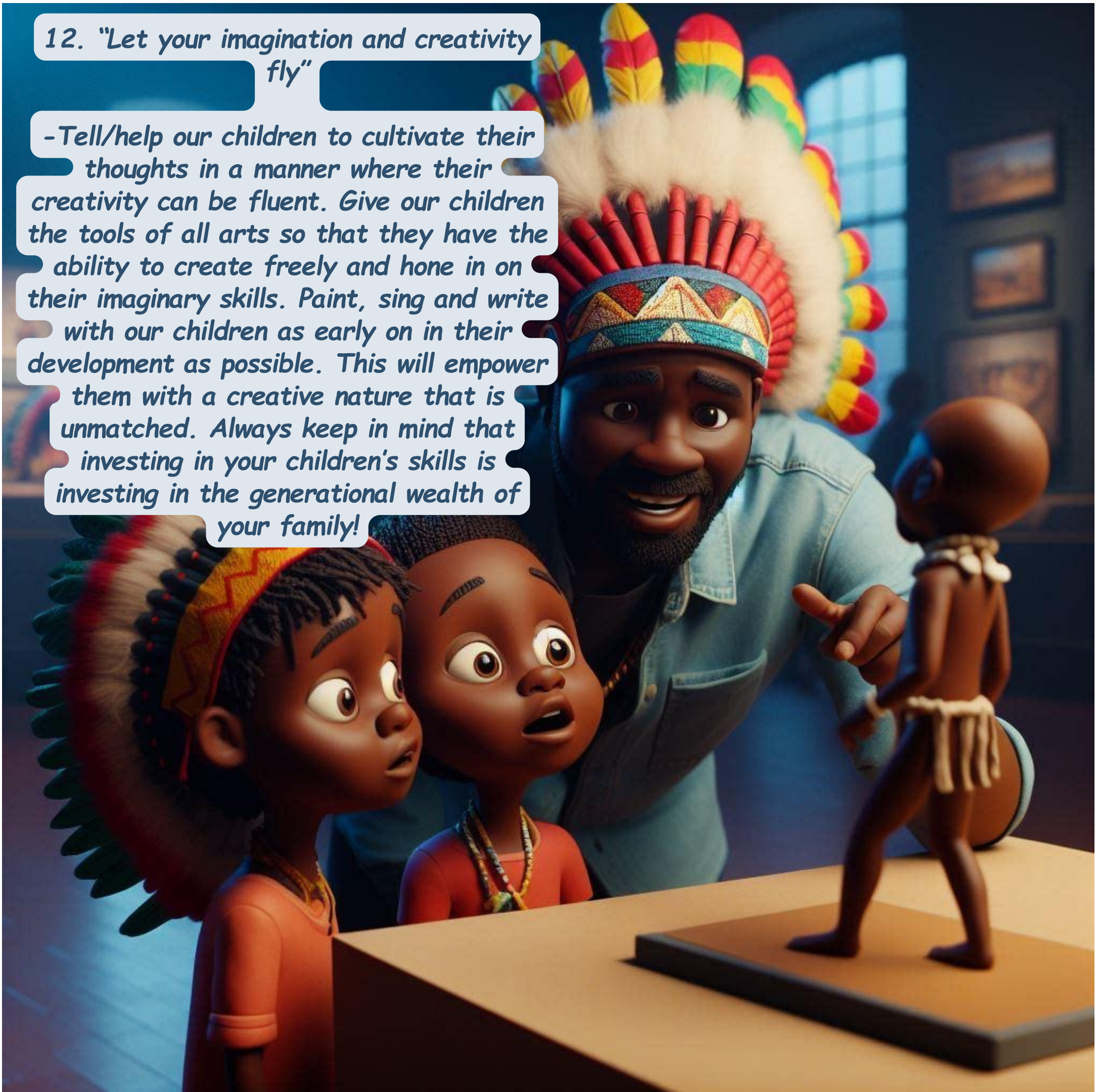


11. "Stay accountable and own decisions"

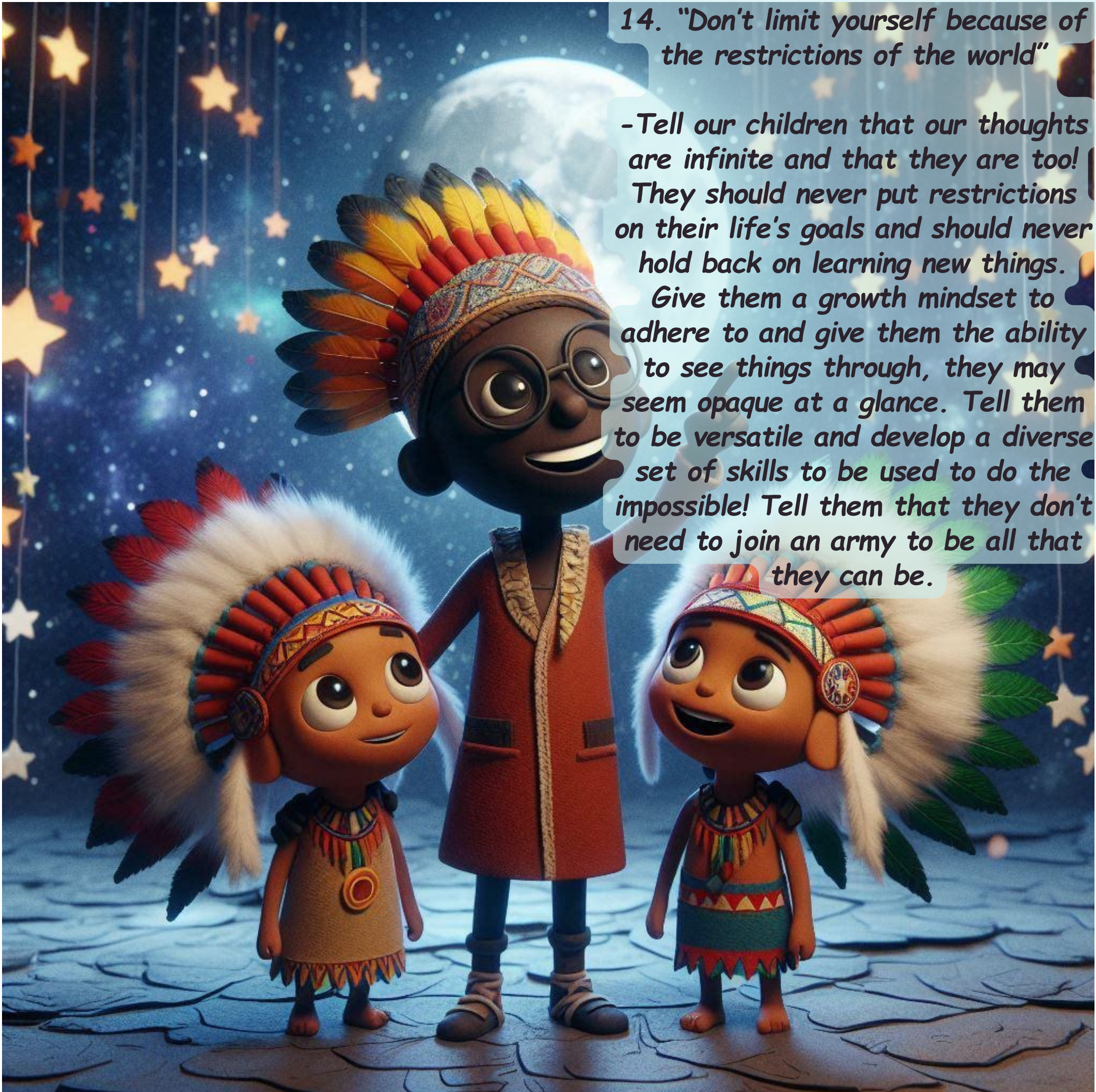
13. "Give everyone the grace and respect that you deserve"

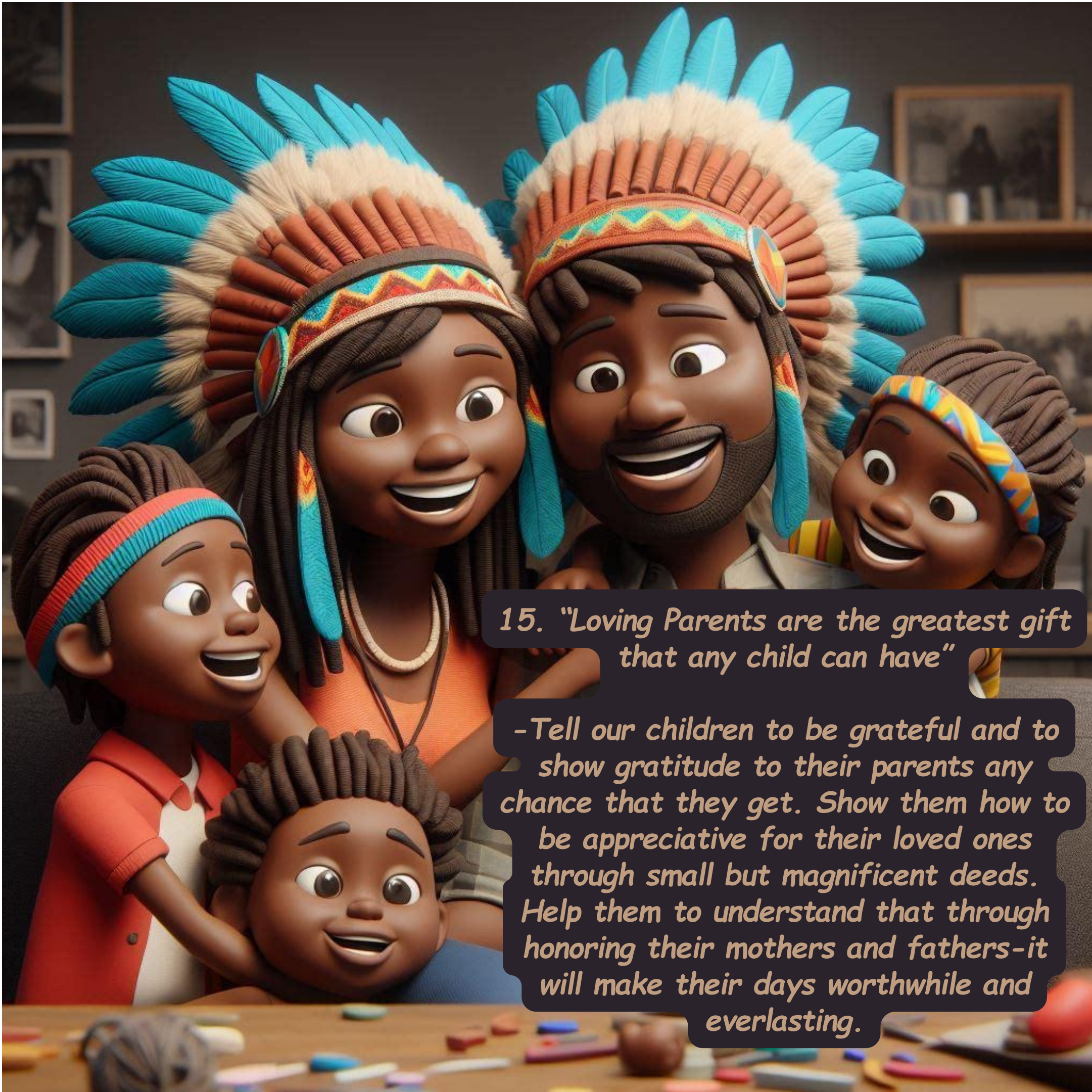
